Making Plans for Growth

Our goal in 2008-2009 is to make Kingdom Children programs available to even more kids! Here are a couple of the steps we're taking this year as we prepare to grow.

Time to Evaluate

As our pilot project in Mwatate reaches maturity, Board members Henry Hengeveld, and Jacob Kramer, along with representatives from the Christian Reformed World Relief Committee, and Anglican Church of Kenya, will complete an on-site evaluation. Also joining this team is Jim Vreugdenhil. Jim's expertise is Christian school curriculum development, and during this time he will dig deep into Kingdom Children's curriculum, spending time meeting with teachers, guardians and the children. The findings of this evaluation will be essential as we expand our program in Mwatate and launch new ones in other Kenyan communities!

Hiring a National Director

We are excited to announce that we have also begun the process of recruiting our first National Director for the Kenyan program! This individual will be key in the formation of new, and maintenance of existing Kingdom Children programs.

- Pray that the evaluation this fall will be fruitful.





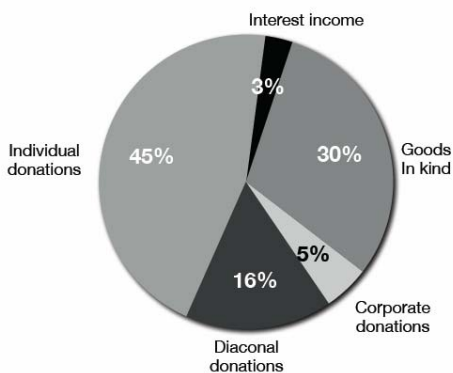
Equipping African children for a lifetime of Kingdom service.

- Pray that stewardship will take root within Kingdom Children communities.

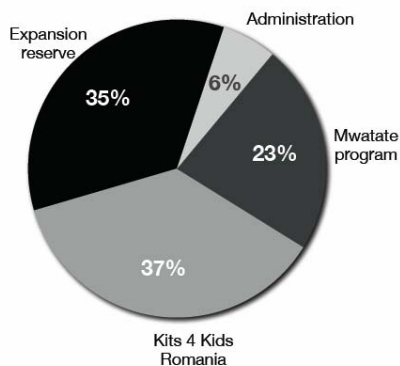
Moving Forward in Faith
